

LAKE HAVASU YACHT CLUB
STANDING RULES

(Approved by the Board 2/09)

1. The Clubhouse shall be open to Members, their immediate family and to guests invited by Members except for periods as maybe designated by the House Committee.
2. The Club offers reciprocity to current members of a recognized Yacht Club.
3. All guests and visitors must register by signing the visitor guest book.
4. Members introducing guests into the Club will be responsible for their conduct while on the premises of the Club.
5. Members and guests shall not bring pets into the Clubhouse.
6. Members shall not reprimand Club employees or volunteer workers. All complaints relative to service must be directed to the House Committee.
7. The Club will not be responsible for any personal property kept in or stored upon the Club premises.
8. All persons using any facility of the Club do so at their own risk.
9. Only local calls may be made from the House Telephone.
10. Member's children shall be under supervision at all times. Children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian when in the bar area of the Club.
11. Members or guests shall not bring into or consume their own liquor on the Clubhouse premises.
12. Food items may be brought into Clubhouse and consumed during scheduled occasions with prior authorizations from the House Committee.
13. All notices for posting in the premises must cleared through the Chairperson of the House Committee.
14. No subscription papers or petitions shall be circulated upon the Club premises, except by special permission of the Board of Directors.
15. Items for sale that are not LHYC related such as fund raisers and commercial items shall not be sold or solicitation made, on the Clubhouse premises.
16. Property, Equipment, or Possessions of the LHYC shall not be removed from the Clubhouse premises or its storage facilities without prior authorizations from the House Committee.
17.
 - A. Reservations shall be necessary for Friday Night Dinners and other Club functions. Members failing to keep Dinner or Event reservations shall be held responsible for the cost of the Dinner or Event.
 - B. Admission to club premises for ticketed events shall be limited to ticket holders only. If not a sell-out, tickets may be purchased at the door for selected events.
18. With the approval of the House Committee and the Board, the Club can be rented to a member for use by the immediate family, or to other organizations for the mutual benefit of both. The Club may not to be used for any commercial or job related party.
19.
 - A. The cooks will be allowed four (4) free dinners, breakfast, etc. that they work.
 - B. A maximum of six (6) free dinners, breakfasts, etc. is allowed for large or special events, providing the Head Cook submits a request to the House Committee.
 - C. Volunteer Bartenders shall be allowed free dinners on the event they are working.
